#### Psalm 51

Have mercy on me, <sup>8</sup> O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.

- 2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!
  - 3 For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.
- 4 Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.
- 5 Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.
- 6 Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.
  - 7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
    - 8 Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.
      - 9 Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.
      - 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right<sup>9</sup> spirit within me.
    - 11 Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

- 12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.
- 13 Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.
- 14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God,O God of my salvation,

and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.

15 O Lord, open my lips,

and my mouth will declare your praise.

16 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.

17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

18 Do good to Zion in your good pleasure;build up the walls of Jerusalem;19 then will you delight in right sacrifices,in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings;then bulls will be offered on your altar.

## Psalm 91

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.

- 2 I will say <sup>10</sup>to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- 3 For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.
  - 4 He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.

  - 7 A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
  - 8 You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked.
- 9 Because you have made the Lord your dwelling place—
  the Most High, who is my refuge<sup>11</sup>—
  10 no evil shall be allowed to befall you,
  no plague come near your tent.
  - 11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.
    - 12 On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.
- 13 You will tread on the lion and the adder; the young lion and the serpent you will trample underfoot.
- 14 "Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him; I will protect him, because he knows my name.
  - 15 When he calls to me, I will answer him;I will be with him in trouble;I will rescue him and honor him.16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."
